

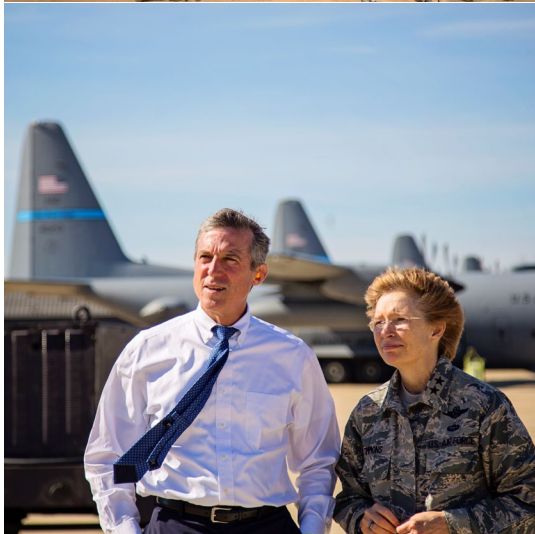

- 1000 Tour: DE Guard Capability Demonstrations

The 31st Civil Support Team (CST) Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) maintains the capability to mitigate the consequences of any WMD or all hazards event, whether natural or man-made. They are experts in WMD effects and NBC defense operations. As the CST is on standby 24/7, the advanced echelon will deploy within 90 minutes of notification and the rest of the team within three hours. This quick response gives the CST the ability to support the incident commander with critical information rapidly.

The Counterdrug Task Force supports the detection, interdiction, disruption, and curtailment of drug trafficking activities in our state through the application of military unique skills and resources. Counterdrug members provide support to local, state and federal law enforcement agencies by assisting in reducing illegal manufacturing, distribution, and use of illicit drugs. The team will demonstrate their Firearms Training Simulator used by local law enforcement.
